# I. INTRODUCTION

This guideline supersedes Guideline No. 12 issued on July 6, 2005, which supersedes Bulletin No. 25 (Revised) **Transfer Courses Acceptable for Credit to Meet the Requirements of the High School Diploma,** dated April 5, 2004. The content has been revised to reflect changes in Division policies or procedures.

### II. GUIDELINE CHANGES

Removed courses that are no longer offered through DACE. Included LA Unified high school courses that meet computer literacy graduation requirements (REF-913.1, Office of Curriculum, Instruction and School Support, January 13, 2013).

# III. APPROVED TRANSFER COURSES

Students from a secondary high school who possess equivalent credits in reading, English and mathematics, but do not demonstrate sufficient skills through appropriate placement instruments will be counseled/enrolled accordingly.

The following high school courses are acceptable for transfer to meet the requirements for the adult high school diploma.
