This Guideline supersedes Guideline No. 56 issued on February 6, 2014. The content has been updated to include U.S Government.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this guideline is to inform all stakeholders about the Adult Secondary Education (ASE) courses that meet "A-G" requirements.

II. INTRODUCTION

The University of California (UC) and the California State University (CSU) have established a set of courses referred to as the "A-G" list that satisfy the Subject Requirements for university admission. The intent of these requirements is to ensure that entering freshmen have the general knowledge, critical thinking abilities, and study skills for undergraduate work at the university level.

On June 14, 2005, the Board of Education approved the Resolution to create educational equity through the implementation of the A-G course sequence as part of the high school graduation requirements. The A-G Resolution establishes a graduation requirement for all students to complete an A-G fifteen course college preparatory sequence beginning fall 2008.
