I. INTRODUCTION

This revision replaces Bulletin No. 30 (Revised) dated July 3, 1998.

The following requirements are effective and apply to students enrolling in the Adult Academic Instruction Program on July 1, 2004, and thereafter.

II. REVISED GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Los Angeles Unified School District authorized Division of Adult and Career Education graduation requirements of 170 semester credits for students not using the GED in partial fulfillment of course work are as follows:
