SUBJECT: HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAM FOR VETERANS IN REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL CENTERS

- I. Clock-Hour Basis Only
- II. Unit Measurement Not To Be Used

- IV. CAS-ROC Delineation

This revision supersedes the bulletin of the same number issued on July 1, 1981. The content has been updated to reflect changes in Division organization, policy, or procedure.

I. CLOCK-HOUR BASIS ONLY

Because the high school diploma program is a concomitant benefit in the occupational center and not the primary objective, veterans at regional occupational centers shall be enrolled for benefits under the clock-hour basis only (30 hours per week for full-time benefits).

II. UNIT MEASUREMENT NOT TO BE USED

Regional occupational centers should not certify courses under the unit measurement for high school diploma courses, even though such courses may be creditable toward the diploma for veterans who have not yet earned the high school diploma.

III. CONCURRENT CAS AND ROC ENROLLMENT

Although concurrent enrollment by a veteran in a community adult school and a regional occupational center program is possible, the veteran should not expect the unit measurement for high school diploma courses to apply toward regional occupational center courses (though such courses may provide elective credit toward the high school diploma).

IV. CAS-ROC DELINEATION

Veterans with a specific vocational objective (though a high school diploma has not been earned) should enroll in regional occupational centers, whereas veterans with primarily a high school diploma objective should enroll in community adult schools.
