SUBJECT: TENURED TEACHERS ASSIGNED TO TEACH IN OTHER THAN THEIR TENURED SUBJECT AREAS

Guidelines for being assigned in areas other than a teacher's tenured subject field are as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

It is the policy of the Division of Adult and Career Education to allow tenured teachers to be assigned to teach in other subject areas for which they are properly credentialed.

II. TEACHERS ASSIGNED WITH DISTRICT FUNDS

With state adult education general funds (1040), tenured teachers may work up to forty (40) hours per week, but are restricted to eighteen (18) hours per week outside of their tenure subject area.

III. TEACHERS ASSIGNED WITH VOCATIONAL AND/OR CATEGORICAL FUNDS

A teacher may be assigned to teach in a vocational or categorically funded program for which they are properly credentialed. This would require a limited contract. The combination of a tenured assignment and a limited contract assignment is limited to 40 hours per week.
